



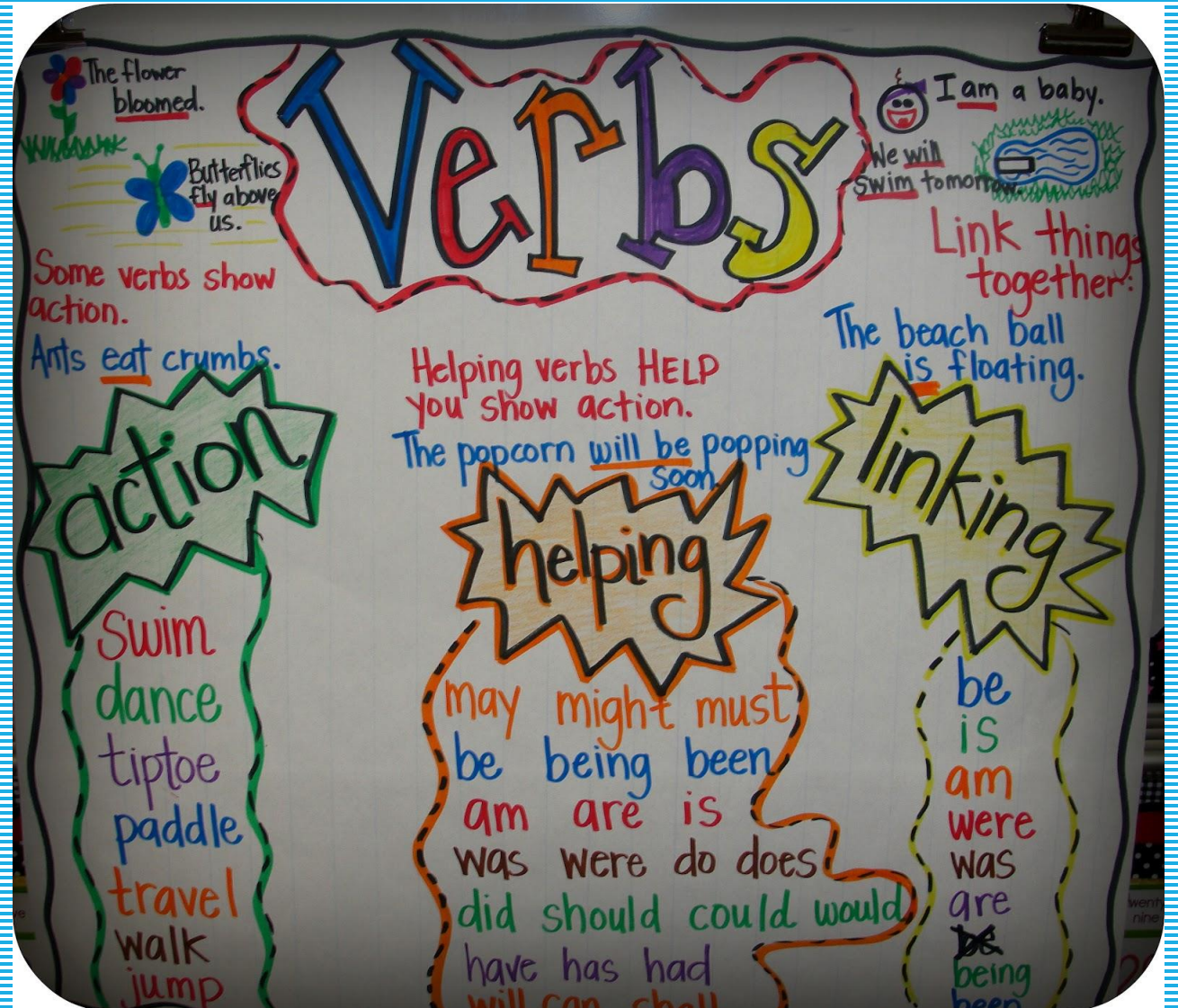

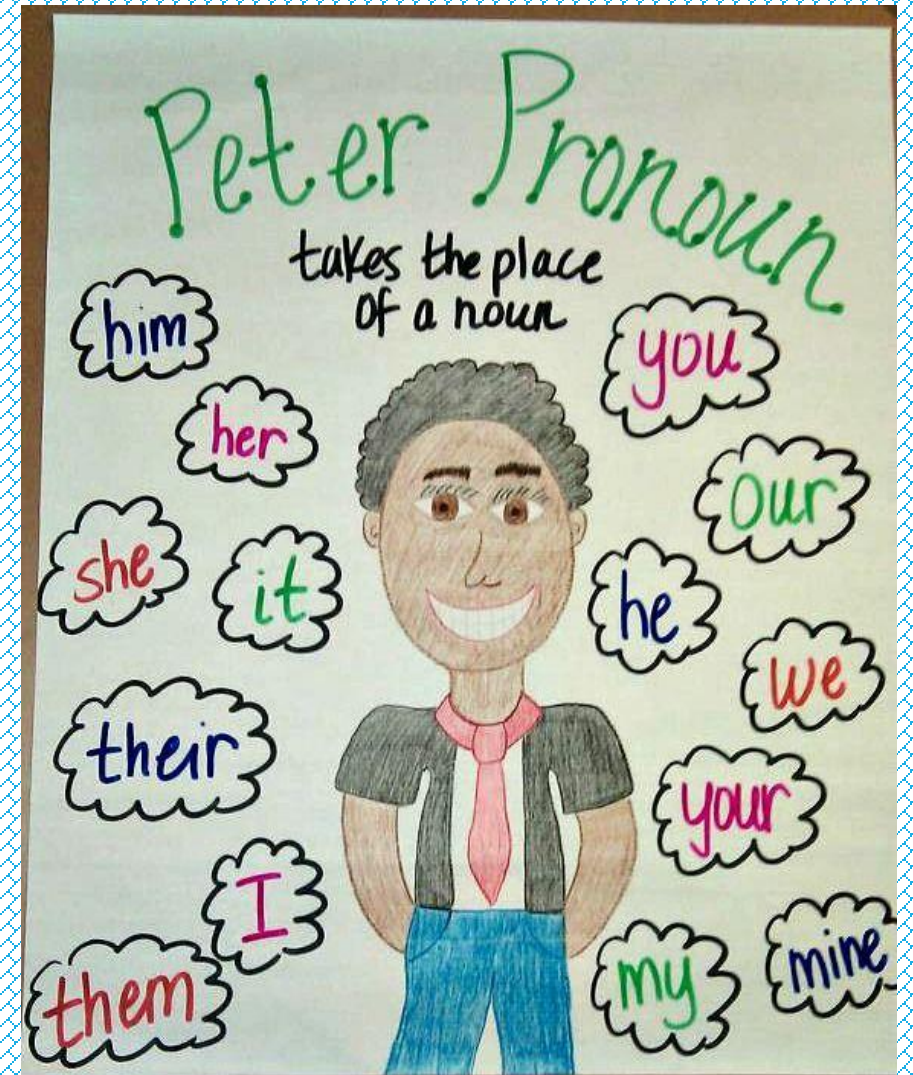

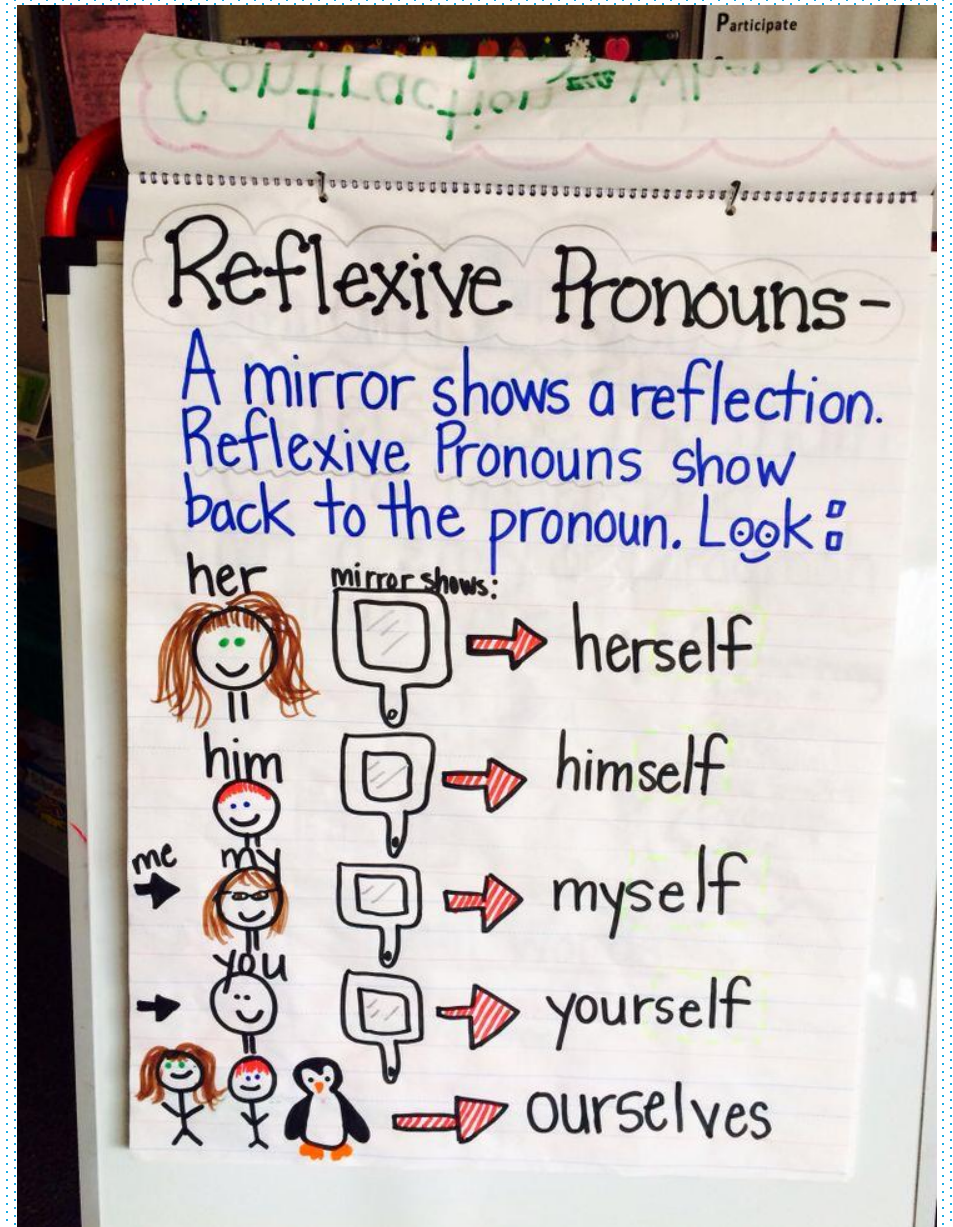

Lions eat other animals.

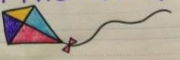
The sun is bright in the sky.

Did your rocket break?

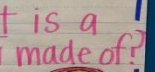
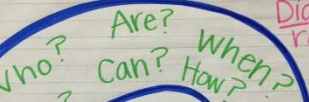
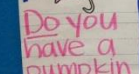
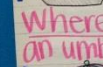
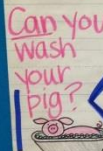

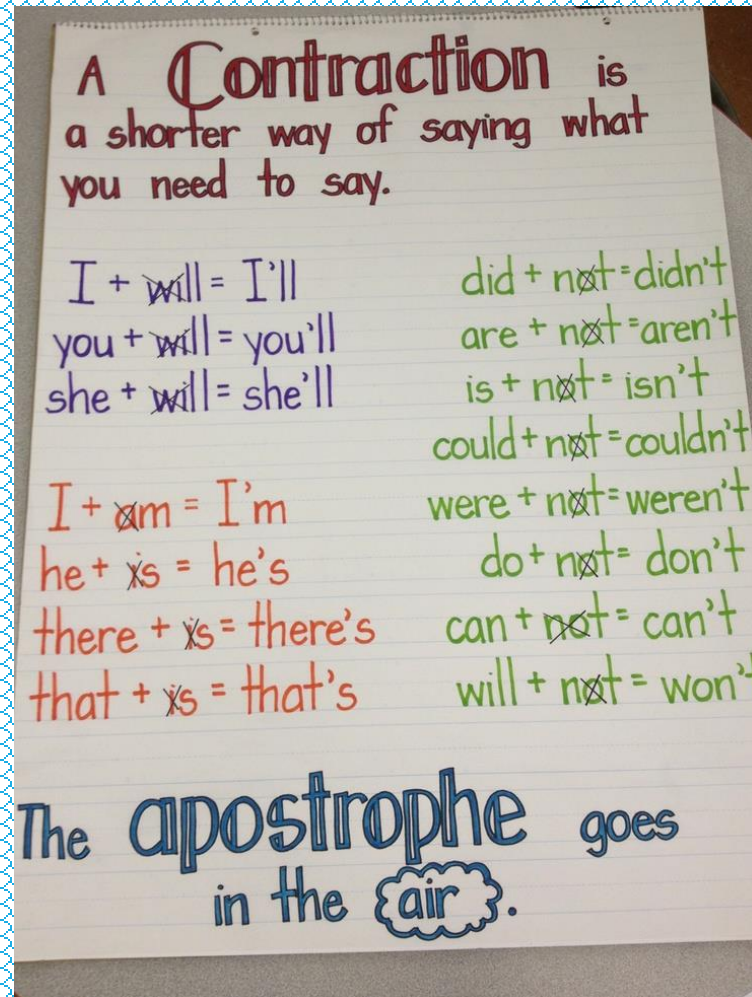
Homophones
